Are you using all the perks of your debit card?

Your debit card works like an electronic check, directly paying for transactions from your account. It is a simple, secure way to pay virtually anywhere. Whether you're getting groceries down the street, making an online purchase, or getting cash from one of our many ATMs, you can use your Visa debit card with confidence.

What's new?

The newest card technology is contactless payments. Contactless technology gives you an additional secure payment option for in-store purchases. All you have to do is hold your card, mobile phone or device close to the contactless symbol on the terminal for one to two seconds (you don't have to tap it, but you can!). It grew significantly in popularity during the COVID-19 pandemic because it's touch free, so you avoid unnecessarily touching surfaces at checkout.

Contactless payments are just as safe and even quicker than inserting or swiping your card. Using the same technology and security as chip cards, a transaction-specific, one-time code accompanies your payment to protect your in-store purchases against fraud.

Our cards come with EMV microchip and contactless technologies. The enhanced features of the chip protect your bank account by issuing a unique code for each transaction, adding a new safeguard against fraud.

Get to know your card.

Our new card design is vertical and offers additional privacy and security. Instead of being embossed, your card details are printed on the back of the card. When you turn it over, you'll see your name, account number, expiration and CVV code on the bottom in white ink.

The front of the card features a one-color bank logo, Visa logo, and the word debit (*which is helpful if you carry more than one Park card in your wallet and don't remember which design is for which account!*). The microchip is the raised gold surface — if you touch it, you'll feel a texture; the wavelength icon indicates the card is enabled for contactless payments.
